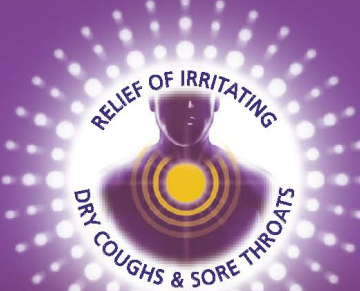




# Dry Coughs NON-DROWSY Blackcurrant Flavour Syrup

Glycerol & Sucrose



## What this medicine is for

Benylin Dry Coughs NON-DROWSY Blackcurrant Flavour Syrup relieves irritating, dry coughs and sore throats.

## Before taking this medicine

This product is suitable for most people, but a few people should not use it. If you are in any doubt contact your doctor or pharmacist.

- X Do not use this medicine...**
  - If you are allergic to any of the ingredients.
  - Do not give this medicine to your child if s/he is under 1 year old.
  - If any of these bullet points apply, get advice from a doctor or pharmacist without using Benylin Dry Coughs NON-DROWSY Blackcurrant Flavour Syrup.
- X Talk to your doctor or pharmacist**
  - If you have been diagnosed with an intolerance to some sugars. If this applies to you now or in the past, talk to a doctor or pharmacist.
- I Some of the ingredients can cause problems**
  - This product contains 2.15 g glucose and 1.7 g sucrose in each 5 ml, which may be harmful to the teeth. If you have been told by your doctor that you have an intolerance to some sugars, contact your doctor before using this medicine. This should be taken into account in patients with diabetes.
  - Carbohydrate content of this medicine is 3.4 g per 5 ml.

## How to use this medicine

Check the information that follows to see how much medicine to take.

- For oral use only.
- Do not take more medicine than the carton (and/or label) tells you to.
- Check the cap seal is not broken before first use. If it is, do not take this medicine.

- I Children under 1 year**  
Do not give to children under 1 year old.
- I Adults and Children 1 year and over**

Age	Dose
Children 1 - 5 years	One 5 ml spoonful to be given to your child 3 or 4 times a day
Adults (including the elderly) and children 5 years and over	Two 5 ml spoonfuls to be taken 3 or 4 times a day.

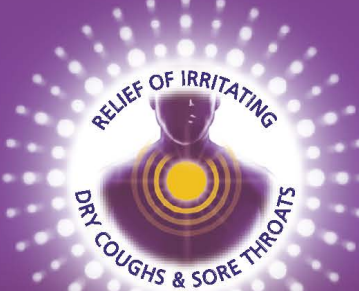
- If you do not feel better or start to feel worse, tell your doctor or pharmacist.

- I Pregnancy and Breast-feeding**
  - You can take this medicine if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- I If anyone has taken too much**  
If anyone has taken too much of this product, contact a doctor or your nearest Accident & Emergency department (Casualty), taking this pack with you.
- I If you forget to take a dose**  
If you forget a dose, take the next dose when needed. Do not take a double dose.

## Possible side-effects

This medicine is unlikely to cause side-effects unless you are allergic to the ingredients. If you get any of these serious side effects, stop taking the medicine. See a doctor at once.

- Unexplained wheezing or difficulty in breathing, swelling of the face, lips, tongue, neck or throat (severe allergic reactions).
- If you notice any other side-effects not listed here or you are not sure about anything, talk to your pharmacist or doctor.

## Reporting of side-effects

If you get any side-effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side-effects not listed in this leaflet. By reporting side-effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

## Storing this medicine

There are no special storage instructions for this medicine. Keep out of the sight and reach of children. Do not use your medicine after the date shown as an expiry date on the packaging. Keep the bottle tightly closed. Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment. Retain carton for full instructions.

## Further information

**What's in this medicine:** The active ingredients in each 5 ml of medicine are: Glycerol 0.75 ml and Sucrose 1.7 g. Other ingredients are: Citric acid monohydrate, sodium benzoate (E211), anthocyanin, blackcurrant flavour, blackcurrant juice, liquid glucose and purified water.

**What the medicine looks like:** Benylin Dry Coughs NON-DROWSY Blackcurrant Flavour Syrup is a clear, purple liquid available in 150 ml bottles. If you need more advice ask your pharmacist.
