1. What Oilatum Gel is and what it is used for

Ollatum Gel contains a medicine called light liquid paraffin. It is used to treat itchy, irritating dry skin problems such as eczema dermatitis. a and Oilatum Gel works by: • soothing, moisturising and conditioning your

- skin
- stopping loss of moisture from your skin.

- This makes your skin: soft and supple. less rough and scaly. less itchy and irritated.

2. Before you use Oilatu m Gel

Do not use Oilatum Gel if: • you are allergic to light liquid paraffin or any of the other ingredients in this medicine (listed in Section 6).

 you have greasy or oily skin.
 Do not use Oilatum Gel if any of the above applies to you. If you are not sure, talk to your pharmacist or doctor before using this medicine

3. How to use Oilatum Gel

If this medicine is from your doctor or pharmacist, do exactly as they have told you Otherwise, follow the instructions below. If you do not understand the instructions or you are not sure, ask your doctor or pharmacist. You should use Ollatum Gel every time you

- Use this medicine only on your skin. Avoid getting this gel in your eyes or on your lips or
- mouth
- mouth. Take care to avoid slipping. This gel may make your shower or bath more slippery. sing Oilatum Gel in the shower, bath or sink Shower or wash as usual. ш



2. When your skin is still wet, rub a small amount of gel between your hands. Gently massage it onto the affected area of your skin. If you are applying the gel onto someone else, your hands as well as the area being treated, should be wet.

 Pat your skin dry with a soft towel. Do not rub as this will remove the Oilatum Gel from your as ti skin.



4. Possible side eff

Like all medicines, Ollatum Gel can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. The following side effects have been reported at the site of application in approximately 1 in 1,000 people

Redness of the skin, rash, irritation or itching
 Allergic type reactions including red, swolle inflamed skin (dermatitis).

Some of these effects can also be symptoms of the condition you are treating. However, if you experience any of these effects for the first time, or you experience worsening of the effects stop use and speak to your doctor or pharmacist.

Reporting of side effects If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leafiet. You can

also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at: www.mhra.gov.uk/yellowcard. By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

5. How to store Oilatum Gel

- Keep out of the sight and reach of children.
 Do not store above 25°C.
- Do not use Oilatum Gel after the expiry date which is stated on the end of the tube as EXP. The expiry date refers to the last day of the ionth.
- Medicines should not be disposed of vic wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
