What Eumocream does

Eumocream is a non-steroid, hydrating treatment cream specifically formulated to moisturise dry, sensitive, itchy skin conditions, including skin prone to eczema and dermatitis. The active ingredient is glycerol which combines with the other ingredients to moisturise and protect your skin by retaining moisture deep within the skin.

Check before vou use

Do not use Fumocream:

• if you have ever had an allergic reaction to glycerol or to any of the other ingredients (see Further information).

Take special care with Eumocream

- · Avoid contact with the eyes.
- Talk to your doctor before using the cream if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.

low to use Eumocream

Use this medicine only on your skin.

Apply the cream to the affected skin as needed. Eumocream can be used on all areas of the body including the face. If your symptoms persist, see your doctor.

ossible side effects

Like all medicines, Eumocream can have side effects, such as local skin reactions, but these are rare.

How to store Eumocream

Keep out of the sight and reach of children.
Do not use this medicine after the 'EXP' date shown on the pack.
Do not store above 25°C. Do not freeze.

Active ingredient The cream contains Glycerol 25% w/w.
Other ingredients Glycerol monostearate 40-55, cetostearyl alcohol, beeswax substitute 6621 (paraffin wax, vegetable stearic acid, prime yellow carnauba wax), arlacel 165 (glycerol monostearate, polyoyethylene 100 stearate), dimeticone, chiorocresol, sodium citrate, citric acid monohydrate and purified water.

Cetostearyl alcohol may cause local skin reactions

(e.g. contact dermatitis). Chlorocresol may cause allergic reactions.
