- What it is used for MEDIKINET is used to treat 'attention deficit hyperactivity disorder' (ADHD). It is used in children and young people between the ages of 6 and 18. It is used only affect hying treatments which do not involve medicines. Sur

   MEDIKINET is not for use as a treatment for ADHD in children under 6 years of age or in adults. It is not known if it is safe or of benefit in these people.

- HOW It WORKS
  MEDIKINET improves the activity of certain parts of the brain which are under-active. The m can help improve attention (attention span), concentration and reduce impulsive behaviour. The medicine is given as part of a treatment programme, which usually includes:

MEDIKINET treatment must only be initiated by, and used under the supervision of, a specialist in childhood and/or adolescent behavioural disorders. Although there is no cure for ADHD, it can be managed using treatment programmes.

Many children and young people straggle to do these things. However, with ADHD they can cause problems with everyday life. Children and young people with ADHD may have difficulty learning and doing homework. They find it hard to behave well all home, at school or in other places. ADHD does not lated the intelligence of a child or young person.
