Information for the patient

- This card contains important safety information that you should know before you are given PEVANTI and during treatment with PEVANTI
 - Show this card to any doctor or nurse involved in your treatment
 - Please carry this card with you at all times
- If you get chickenpox while taking PEVANTI, you can become seriously ill.
- Keep away from people who have chickenpox if you have never had them.
 - If you do come into contact with someone with chickenpox, you must see your doctor or pharmacist straightaway. Your doctor may want to give you a vaccination to help stop you from getting chicken pox
 - If you do catch Chickenpox, tell your doctor straightaway. Your doctor will advise you on how to take PEVANTI.
- During PEVANTI treatment, telephone your doctor or tell your carer immediately if you feel dizzy or become unwell.
- Do not stop taking PEVANTI, or change your dose, unless told by your doctor.
