

**Patient Reminder Card**

You have been given this card because you have been prescribed Toctino▼ (alitretinoin). Please read this card and the package information leaflet thoroughly before starting your treatment with Toctino.

**Important information to know:**

Toctino must not be taken during pregnancy. Toctino can seriously harm an unborn baby if a pregnant woman takes it. If you become pregnant or think you might be pregnant, stop taking Toctino immediately and contact your doctor.

If you have any questions or concerns about taking Toctino, talk to your doctor or pharmacist.

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**What you must do:**

- You must not become pregnant while taking Toctino, or for 1 month after stopping treatment.
- You must attend regular follow-up visits and have regular pregnancy testing, ideally every month.
- You must use effective contraception before, during and for 1 month after stopping treatment with Toctino.

**Reminder for Men and Women**

Do not share this medication with anybody and return any unused capsules back to the pharmacy.

You should not donate blood during treatment with this medicine and for one month after stopping.
