**IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS**  
**PLEASE READ AND KEEP**

Dear Patient,

You have been given this card because you have been administered methoxyflurane, and there is some important safety information you should be aware of.

This medicine can cause liver and kidney problems which can occur in the days or weeks after use. Although this is rare, it can be life-threatening so **seek medical attention IMMEDIATELY and show the healthcare professional this card if you experience any of the symptoms listed opposite:**

- Loss of appetite
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Jaundice (yellowing of the skin and/or eyes)
- Dark coloured urine
- Pale coloured stools
- Pain/ache or sensitivity to touch in your right stomach area (below your ribs)
- Reduced or excessive urination
- Swelling of feet or lower legs
